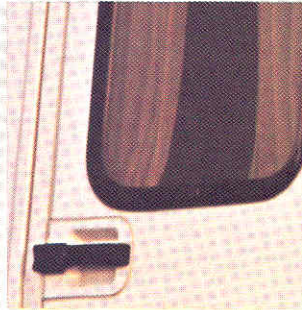

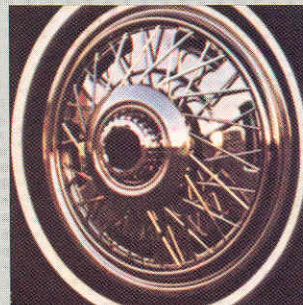

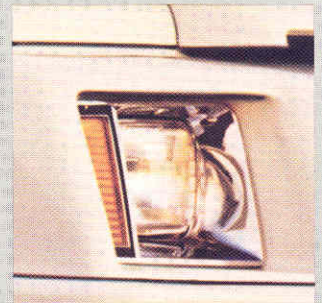

LeSharo® gives you all of the advantages of a Winnebago in a vehicle that's designed for a lot more than just motor homing.

So while it is ideal for special occasions, it's also perfect for everyday use.

Like a motor home, LeSharo is a true vacation vehicle. It has comfortable lounge chairs for relaxing and enough beds to sleep four. It has a kitchen for whipping up meals and a dinette for polishing them off. There's even an on-board bathroom. And LeSharo is designed to be fully self-contained. So you can live on the road just as you can in a full-sized motor home.

But unlike an ordinary motor home, LeSharo is low and lean. With its front wheel drive, rack and pinion steering and MacPherson strut front suspension, Motor Home magazine said it "corners... like a sports car." An aerodynamic steel front end and aluminum-covered sidewalls give strength and light weight to its sleek body.

LeSharo also gives you the choice of either a fuel-injected gasoline engine with a three speed automatic transmission or a turbo-charged diesel engine with a four speed manual.

Then there's its unbelievable mileage estimate—22 mpg on the highway with the turbo-charged diesel engine. Not only does it make LeSharo the most efficient motor home ever built, it makes LeSharo more efficient than many vans and several passenger cars.

The 22 mpg estimate was determined under actual driving

conditions, not in a laboratory. The United States Auto Club independently tested a prototype vehicle across 3,142 miles of American highways, with constantly varying road grades and conditions.*

With its efficiency and drivability, LeSharo is one motor home that doesn't have to spend Monday through Friday sitting in the driveway. It makes an ideal vehicle for car-pooling, grocery shopping or simply getting around town. At less than 20 feet long, it's nearly as easy to parallel park as a station wagon.

When the weekend rolls around, LeSharo really rolls into action. And weekends are just the beginning. You can take LeSharo anywhere, any time. It is perfect for vacations or holidays, or even trips to see friends or relatives. It even makes a unique extra bedroom when you get there. Just plug in the power cord and you'll have electricity for lights, kitchen appliances, even air conditioning.

In all, it might seem hard to believe Winnebago engineers could design such an efficient and comfortable vehicle in such a short period of time. But they did.

In a little more than two years their eight-million-dollar investment produced a driving machine which took the pleasures of motor homing and cut them down to size.

And in the process, created something that's going to be very big.

*Your mileage may vary. The prototype was identical to a LeSharo without a sink, range, refrigerator and marine toilet. Although the testing achieved an average rating of 24.11 mpg, added weight could lower diesel mileage to 22 mpg. Mileage with the gas engine will be somewhat less.

Inside, LeSharo's not just a motor home. It's a miracle.

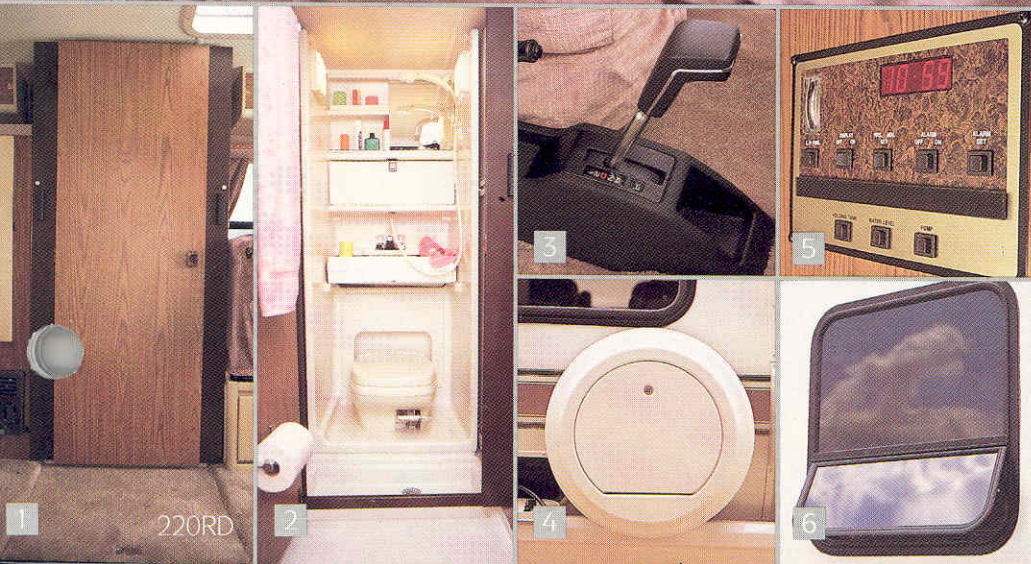
You can choose LeSharo with either of two floorplans, depending on your needs. The LeSharo 220RD has a center bathroom and shower, a rear dinette and two companion lounge seats. The 220RC has a rear corner bath and a mini rear dinette.

Both models have a complete galley, with everything necessary for preparing snacks or meals. There's a two-burner gas stove, stainless steel sink and a two-cubic-foot 12-volt refrigerator.

Throughout the interior, you'll find the kind of attention to detail that has made Winnebago famous. Overhead cabinets, a lighted closet in the 220RC and storage compartments under the companion seats provide ample room for your gear. A monitor panel keeps you updated on LeSharo's various systems. There is even an oak beverage tray in the cab.

All fabrics, carpeting and furnishings combine for a rich, inviting decor. Screened windows provide plenty of cross-ventilation. For warmer weather, both automotive air conditioning and a roof air conditioner are available.

In all, LeSharo gives you more than you would expect from almost any vehicle.

To build a motor home like LeSharo requires much more than just conventional thinking. It requires imaginative thinking.

The advantage of LeSharo's front wheel drive, for instance, is not merely the road-hugging traction it affords the driver. It also allows for a unique split level floorplan which has a six-foot ceiling in the middle, where you stand, and a lower ceiling on the ends, where you sit.

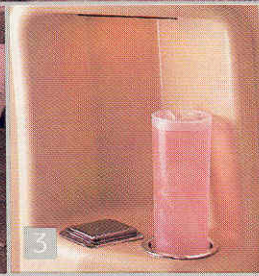
And since there are no heavy drive line components, LeSharo's floor at the entrance door is only eleven inches off the ground. For comparison, the floor of a typical van is 27 inches above the ground. You don't climb into LeSharo, you step into it.

LeSharo's bathroom is worth closer examination as well. In the 220RD, it can be "stored away" when not in use. But by simply pulling the walls out, it suddenly becomes a completely private bathroom with a toilet, lavatory and full stand-up shower.

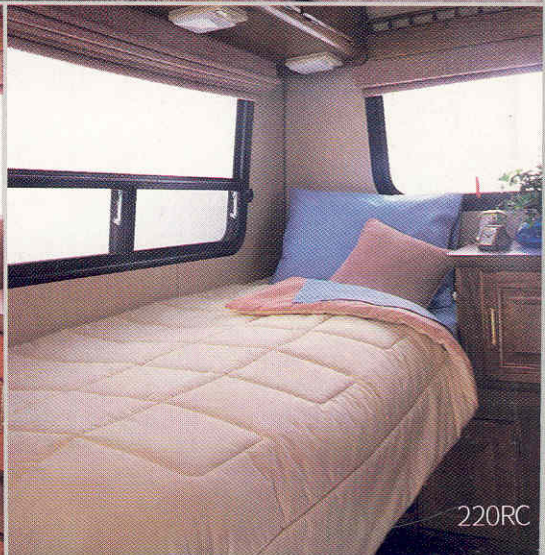
Up front, LeSharo's cockpit is made for the simple pleasures of driving. It offers the comfort of reclining bucket seats and power steering, plus several options from cruise control and power door locks, to a deluxe AM/FM/cassette stereo system.

So if you're looking for a vehicle that you can take across country as easily as you can take across town, take a look at LeSharo.
